

Corona Virus Covid-19 Update

With the government announcing an escalation into the 'delay' stage in the outbreak of Corona Virus (Covid-19), we wanted to detail the current actions Survival-32 are undertaking to minimise the risk to the disruption of supplies to our customers.

Some of the steps we have initiated:

- Enabled immediate remote working of some office staff to reduce contact between employees, with the ability to enable all office staff to work remotely so we can continue to process orders and work as normal.
- Ensured operational employees have cover in case of staff shortages.
- We have for the last couple of weeks increased preventative measures covering cleaning regimes, hygiene practices and reduced physical contact with persons not employed by Survival-32.

We are currently seeing high level of demand for cleaning products, medicines and mouthwashes which has resulted in some lines being out of stock, but we are working closely with our suppliers to ensure these stock shortages are minimised as much as possible and all back orders are despatched as soon as stock arrives with us.
